### **MADRID**

### The Prado

Most famous Madrid art gallery Extensive collection of works from 12<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> Centuries Includes works by Goya, Rubens & Murillo

### Reina Sofia

Impressive Gallery with more recent works from 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> Centuries Lots of Picasso pieces including famous Guernica

# Thyssen-Bornemisza

This art gallery is the most popular in Madrid Best private collection of 13<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> Century Art Works by Titian, Goya, Durero, Renoir, Kadinsky and more

# <u>Valencia</u>

#### **IVAM**

An exclusively modern art museum dedicating itself more to promotion of new names.

#### Valeriola Palace

Only privately owned large art centre in Valencia.

### Royal Shipyards Art Museum

National Artistic Monument dedicated mainly to contemporary modern art.

### **BARCELONA**

### MACBA (Barcelona Museum of Contemporary Art)

Displays of art from the second half of the 20<sup>th</sup> Century During our visit, MACBA showcases multi-sensory art

# Sagrada Familia

Large Roman Catholic church designed by the Catalan architect Antoni Gaudi. The church is now a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

#### La Pedrera

Another one of Antonio Gaudi's creations which is complete. The building has wavy brick work and colourful tiles – a masterpiece.

#### Picasso Museum

Picasso's paintings are arranged from his early days to his final works

#### Miro Museum

Showcase of comprehensive works by Joan Miro

Barcelona's most famous street!

### **Barcelona Art Galleries**

Galeria Artevistas – posh uptown galleries showcase known artists with several zeros attached to the price!

Cosmo – tree lined Pedestrian Street filled with outdoor cafes and well established art galleries

Angels Barcelona – International artists are part of the impressive repertoire of this gallery

Ulls Blaus and Niu – Mostly recycled material is used in the paintings and objects on display
