Committed service in any of the following: Interact - all outings and projects, also Santa Shoebox, Tekkie tax etc. Drama / Music (technical help, back stage etc. during productions) Sport - tech table, umpiring, coaching, medics Involvement in any other community service (Epilepsy, Hospice, Kaws etc.)	A certificate will be awarded after participation in any service activity / Interact for 18 hours over one year. Or 80% attendance of and active participation in Interact projects and meetings. Certificates can be awarded from Grade 8 and above.	Half colours: Awarded after at least 3 certificates have already been awarded in one or more different areas of service. Full colours: Awarded after a further 2 certificates have been awarded (i.e 5 certificates) This can only be awarded from Grade 10 and above.	Honours: Awarded after a further 2 certificate has been awarded (i.e. 7 certificates) There is no time limit, but will probably only be awarded in grades 11 or 12.

Notes: Awarding of certificates is left to the discretion of the teacher(s) in charge. Participants in Presidents' Awards (even if not members of the Interact Club) can qualify. If an activity is not managed by the school, the candidate would need to provide proof of involvement.

SRC: Will be awarded a certificate for Service to School at Celebration of Excellence. This does not fall into any of the above categories.
