



## Congratulations to our 2025 Matriculants!

Our Class of 2025 has achieved some wonderful results, both individually and collectively. In addition to the continuous record of 100% Pass Rate, this year Oakhill's Matric group has also achieved a **100% Bachelor Degree Pass** - qualifying all candidates to study further at tertiary level.

The Matric 2025 group achieved 51 distinctions out of a class of 26 students, with an average of **1,96** distinctions per candidate. Of the 51 subject distinctions, **12 of these were above 90%**.

Congratulations to our Dux Scholar, Kay-Lane Cloete who earned the accolade of Outstanding Achievement with 6 distinctions, with an aggregate of 85%. Aidan Brewer and Ester Mwanza both earned Commendable Achievement with 5 distinctions each. All of these students achieved overall A-aggregate, as did Liam Hayward and Maia Wildeman.

Two students were recognised by the IEB for achieving in the Top 1% in individual subjects nationally, Aidan Brewer for Mathematics (97%) and Computer Applications Technology (92%) and Kay-Lane Cloete for Life Orientation (96%).
